COURSE DESCRIPTION

In this class, we will sing, dance, act, and have a lot of fun because of all the hard work we will be doing. This semester we will work together on understanding musical theater better by learning more about the history of musical theater, learning the basics of ballet, jazz, tap, etc., the basics of vocal performance, and how to act through singing and dancing.

UNIT TESTS

- Benchmark test at the end of a unit
- Students must pass EVERY Unit Test with a minimum of 70% to pass the class
 - If a test is NOT passed **your grade will be switched to an “F” until the test is passed.**
 - You MUST request an “I” from me if you want to come in for PRIDE to fix it
 - Students that do not pass a test will not pass the class until you pass the test
 - You will receive either the average of your two test scores, or a 75%, whichever is the highest

TERM FINAL EXAMS

- The final for this class is the performance **DECEMBER 14**. There will be at least one tech rehearsals after school during this week. There is no make up for this performance, please put this on your calendar now.

REHEARSAL POINTS

- Based on attendance, tardiness, and participation in class activities
- This is a class with a LOT of group work. PLEASE try not to schedule appointments during our class because it will affect not only YOUR work, but also the work of the group you are with. Try to be respectful of everyone’s time.
- If you miss a performance, and it is excused, you will be given an alternate assignment to make up the grade equivalent to the time missed in class
