## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This class will focus on the development of proficiency in the following fields: costumes, props, lighting, sound, scenic design, dramaturgy and stage management.

Students help with running the technical aspects of our school's drama program, as well as running the school auditorium and working with the administration to assure the success of events that take place there (assemblies and auditorium rentals).

## CLASS EXPECTATIONS

- Be prepared for every class
- Be positive! ☺ Don't tell me you can't do it until you have *shown* me that it can't be done.
- Safety is a number one priority: ABSOLUTELY NO GOOFING AROUND WILL BE TOLERATED IN OR AROUND THE BOOTH, TECH SHOP, AND MACHINERY!
- Students must exhibit a mature and professional attitude concerning the atmosphere in the classroom. This includes taking responsibility for personal items as well as tools, costumes, props and other equipment belonging to the school. NO FOOD OR DRINK WILL BE ALLOWED AROUND THE SOUND AND LIGHT BOARD.
- The only people allowed in the booth are those with tech passes.

## MATERIALS NEEDED

## UNIT TESTS

- Students must tech 2 events each term (ex. assemblies, rentals, after school meets, clubs, concerts, etc.)
- Benchmark test at the end of a unit
- Students must pass EVERY Unit Test with a minimum of 70% to pass the class
  - If a test is NOT passed **your grade will be switched to an “F” until the test is passed.**
  - You must request an “I” from me if you want to come in during PRIDE.
  - If you do not pass the test, you will not pass the class until you pass the test.
  - You will receive either the average of your two test scores, or a 75%, whichever is the highest

## PARTICIPATION

- Based on attendance, tardiness, and participation in production projects (these include school performances & assemblies)
- This is a class with a lot of group work and activities outside of class. Please try not to schedule appointments during our class, because it will affect not only your work, but the work of the group you are with. Try to be respectful of everyone’s time.
- You will be expected to attend all events you have been scheduled to tech for. If you cannot make it, YOU are responsible to find your replacement.
- All students are required to be at the strike of a show after the show closes. They will not be kept later than 11:00.
